Privacy Statement

The Mobile Payment Forum (MPF) uses a subscription form for individuals to subscribe to its mailing list. The mailing list is used to distribute news and updates about the Mobile Payment Forum and its activities.

Choice / OPT-IN

You choose to receive MPF information by opting-in. We will send email to the email address provided on the subscription form to confirm your subscription and the validity of the provided email address. Your reply to this email is necessary for completing the subscription process.

Correct / Update

If you need to change the email address subscribed to the mailing list, first unsubscribe your current email address and then, resubscribe with your new email address. All email list welcome messages contain the information necessary for subscription and removal from their appropriate list. If you need assistance, you may send email to info@mobilepaymentforum.org.

Unsubscribe

We provide unsubscribe/opt-out instructions in all emails sent to the email list. All email list welcome messages contain the information necessary for removal from the list. Removals are instant and automated by our servers.

Sharing Information

The Mobile Payment Forum does not share, sell or rent your email address to outside third parties. We do not supplement your personally identifiable information with any outside third party information.

IP address

The Mobile Payment Forum monitors use of its Web Site. We use your IP address to gather broad demographic information such as browser type, access times, operating system, country of origin, page views, and users sessions to help diagnose problems with our servers, and to administer our Web Site.

Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's computer. The Mobile Payment Forum does not use cookies on its public Web Site. The members-only segment of the Web Site requires login and uses session ID cookies to ensure security and manage access control. Furthermore, once a member closes the browser the cookie simply terminates.

Security

The Mobile Payment Forum Web Site has security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under its control. Sensitive data, such as credit card information, collected through MPF's Web Site is transferred via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) server only. MPF employees are made aware of all security policies and are maintaining and protecting your personally identifiable information.

If there are any material changes to how we use your personal information, we will notify you via email and provide you with the opportunity to opt-out prior to implementing the change.
